Minimum age	Full ability to contract only with 18
Internet access	No relevance, since there is no sharing of private access data of users - telcos' customer access data are under strict data protection law
E-mail sharing	Customers' access data are under strict data protection law; Possibly to block inappropriate email contact
IPTV sharing	TV propositions today without possibility for minors to share privacy with other users
