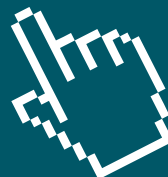

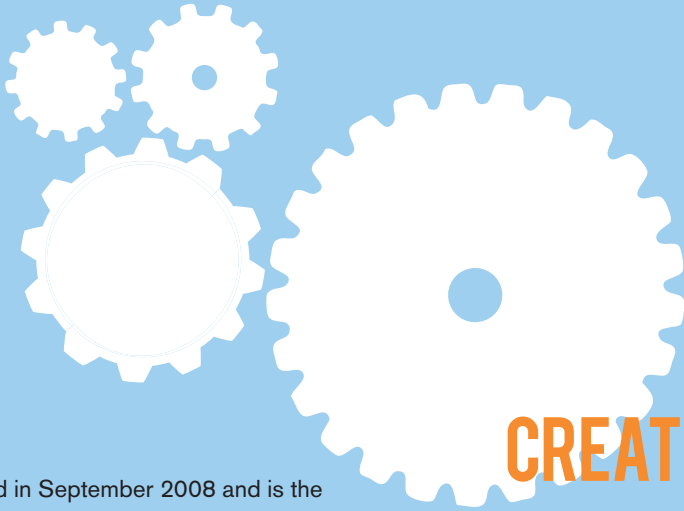

About Us

eNACSO was launched in September 2008 and is the EU's first NGO network dedicated solely to advocating for European and international action on online child safety. The network consists of leading NGOs from, at present, 19 EU Member States. eNACSO also works closely with NGOs from outside the EU, through our Associate Members.

Why child safety online?

Children and young people benefit enormously from the communication and information potential of the internet and are a major constituency of internet users. However, there are a number of risks associated with the internet. For example children can be exposed to age-inappropriate material or illegal content.

What does eNACSO do?

In line with Article 3 of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, we advocate for the best interest of the child to be taken into account in all relevant national, European and international legislative and policy-making forums with an interest in the Internet and the new technologies more generally.
